CRVC Meeting


Saturdays, February 8th & March 8th, 2025 "Water Spiral" with Terri Bay on Zoom

You have a choice of four different designs, all worked on 18-mesh canvas. Each design is 5" square. CRVC will be providing the charted patterns/instructions. Note that two of the designs -- the straight-up butterflies -- may be stitched as half and made into an eyeglass case like the model shown.

CRVC members will teach an "Introduction to Ribbon Embroidery" workshop at the Cossitt Branch of the Granby Public Library on Tuesday April 1, 2025, from 1:30 to 3:30 PM. We will demonstrate several simple stitches that can be combined into flowers to adorn projects such as bookmarks, eyeglass cases, or small bags. We need 4-5 volunteers to help with this.
