Wendy has an MFA degree in Costume Design and has received the National Academy of Needlearts Teacher's Certification in canvas embroidery. Canvas work is her area of expertise although she also enjoys Hardanger, Bargello and Blackwork and one of her goals is to bring these other forms of counted thread work into her canvas designs.

I met Wendy at the EGA Boston Seminar last year and I was able to see this piece on display and it is absolutely stunning. The picture does not do it justice at all. This design leaves the viewer in a peaceful state. The moon itself will appear to glow on its own with a softness expressed with Vineyard, Pepper Pot and Planet Earth silk threads which are included in her kit. Antique Blue 18 ct. mono canvas is used, and the finished piece is 6" x 7". If you would like more information on this piece, please contact me.

It is an honor to have Wendy teach us the many stitches used in canvas work and how to complete this beautiful piece that you will treasure forever. If you are interested, it's a wonderful opportunity to learn from this talented teacher.

Information:

Students to provide: 12" stretcher bars (2 pairs), tacks or staples, frame or frame-weight, laying tool (mandatory), usual stitching supplies, light and magnification recommended. She would also recommend a light-colored towel or napkin to place under your stitching to help count the dark canvas.
